History

In **1995**, **ProTrans**, a **SMME**, started its plant hire business with then a 15-year-old tip truck. Over the years various other pieces of plant were acquired. Currently the fleet exceeds **40 quality and heavy-duty plant items**.

Initially ProTrans focussed on **hiring** plant to the construction industry, mainly to emerging contractors in KZN and E Cape, engaged in rural road works.

Today **ProTrans Plant and Civils (PPC)** is capable of doing **civil projects**, having specialised in mass earth and road works and achieving a **grading of 6 CEPE** with the **Construction Industry Development Board**.

PPC is a **level one BEE** contributor.

Since 2016 PPC has been **RTMS accredited** for compliance with various **SABS codes** relating to **road safety, vehicle maintenance, risk management and overall efficiency**.

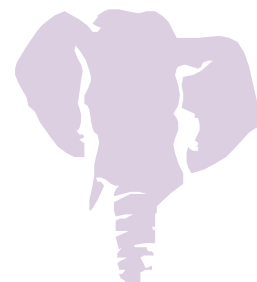
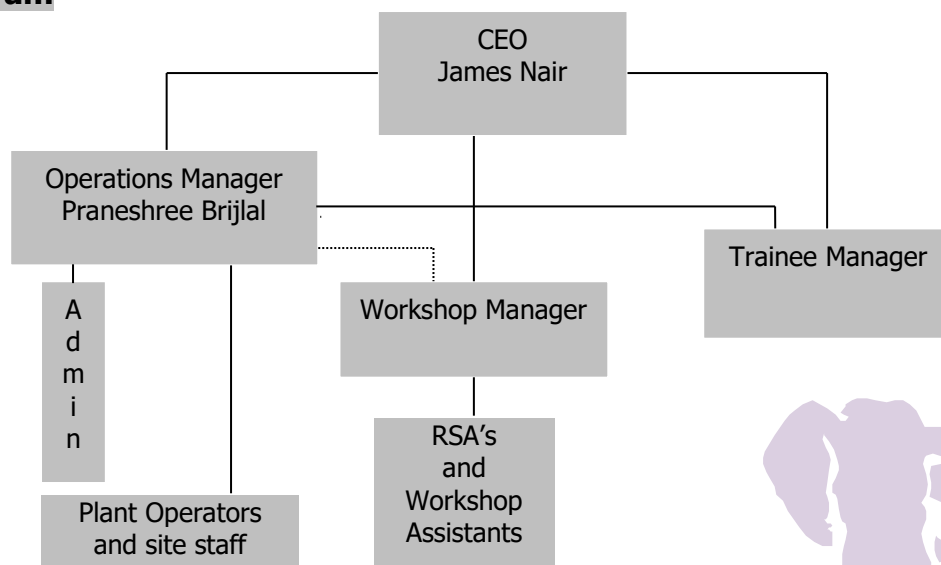
Manpower

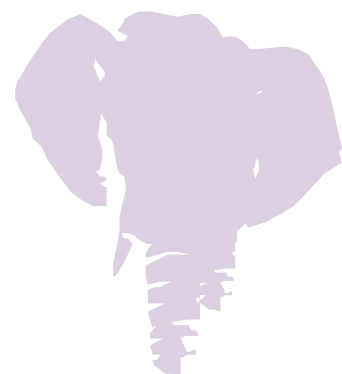
